



Persian Tiles Errata

Unfortunately, although every effort was made at the time of publication to ensure that this pattern was accurate, there are a few errors in the printed pattern.

We can only sincerely apologise for these errors and assure you we will endeavour to improve our working practises.

The corrections are underlined in the pattern copy.

Persian Granny Square (page 6)

ROUND 4 (RS FACING): Using Teal, join yarn into any 3ch-sp by working 1ch + 2ch (counts as 1tr), [2tr, 3ch, 3tr] into same ch-sp, * 1ch, [3tr into next ch-sp, 1ch] twice, [3tr, 3ch, 3tr] into next ch-sp; repeat from * twice more, 1ch, [3tr into next ch-sp, 1ch] twice, ss to 3rd ch of 3ch at beginning of round to join, fasten off. (48tr and 16ch-sps)

Edging (page 10)

ROUND 1 (RS FACING): Using Navy and **3.5mm hook**, join yarn into a corner st by working 1ch (does not count as a st), 1dc into same st, mark last st, * 11dc along side edge of triangle, 2dc into join, [22htr along side edge of Octagon Motif, 2dc into join, 23dc along side edge of next triangle, 2dc into join] 3 times, 22htr along side edge of Octagon Motif, 2dc into join, 11dc along side edge of next triangle, 1dc into corner st, mark last st; repeat from * to end, omitting final dc into corner st on final pattern repeat, ss to join, fasten off. (784 sts total; 195 sts between each of the 4 marked corner sts)

There are no corrections on Rounds 2 and 3 but they are given here to make working the edging easier.

ROUND 2 (RS FACING): Using Aqua and **3.5mm hook**, join yarn into any marked corner st by working 1ch + 2ch (counts as 1tr), 2tr into same st, 3ch, 3tr into same st, * [1ch, skip 3sts, 3tr into next st] to next marked st, 1ch, ** skip 3sts, 3tr into marked st, 3ch, 3tr into same st; repeat from * to end, omitting corner group on final pattern repeat and so ending at **, ss to join, fasten off. (50 blocks of 3tr along each side = 200 blocks of 3tr)

ROUND 3 (RS FACING): Using Teal and **3.5mm hook**, join yarn into any 3ch corner sp by working 1ch + 2ch (counts as 1tr), 2tr into same sp, 3ch, 3tr into same sp, * [1ch, skip 3sts, 3tr into next ch-sp] to next 3ch-sp, 1ch, ** skip 3sts, 3tr into 3ch-sp, 3ch, 3tr into same sp; repeat from * to end, omitting corner group on final pattern repeat and so

ending at **, ss to join, fasten off. (51 blocks of 3tr along each side = 204 blocks of 3tr)

ROUND 4 (RS FACING): Using **4mm hook** and Navy, join yarn into any 3ch corner sp by working 1ch (does not count as st), 3dc into same ch-sp, * 1dc into each next 3sts, [1dc into next ch-sp, 1dc into each next 3sts] to next 3ch-sp, 3dc into 3ch-sp; repeat from * to end, omitting 3dc corner group on final pattern repeat, ss to join, fasten off. (824 sts)

ROUND 5 (RS FACING): Using **4mm hook** and Cream, join yarn into central dc of any 3dc group made at corner by working 1ch, 3dc into same st, * 1dc into each next 205sts, 3dc into next st (this should be central dc of 3dc group); repeat from * to end, omitting 3dc corner group on final pattern repeat, ss to join, fasten off. (832 sts)

ROUND 6 (RS FACING): Using **3.5mm hook** and Navy, join yarn into central dc of any 3dc group made at corner by working 1ch (does not count as a st), 3dc into same st, * 1dc into each next 207sts, 3dc into next st (this should be central dc of 3dc group); repeat from * to end, omitting 3dc corner group on final pattern repeat, ss to join, fasten off. (840 sts)



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
